Hydrogen Permitting Simplification Act

This bill exempts certain major federal actions, including actions that produce hydrogen from nuclear, solar, wind, or geothermal energy sources, from requirements under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969.

Actions Timeline

- **Apr 28, 2023:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Energy, Climate and Grid Security.
- **Apr 27, 2023:** Introduced in House
- **Apr 27, 2023:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Natural Resources, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
