Summary (as of Jan 11, 2023)

One School, One Nurse Act of 2023

This bill directs the Department of Education (ED) to award competitive grants to eligible entities for recruiting, hiring, and retaining school nurses. An eligible entity is a local educational agency (LEA) or a partnership between a state educational agency and a consortium of LEAs in the state.

Further, ED must specify in regulation the recommended nurse-to-student ratios for elementary and secondary schools.

Actions Timeline

- **Jan 20, 2023:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Jan 11, 2023:** Introduced in House
- **Jan 11, 2023:** Referred to the Committee on Education and the Workforce, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
