### Summary (as of May 5, 2023)

### Coast Guard Combat-Injured Tax Fairness Act

This bill extends a tax benefit related to combat-related severance pay to veterans of the Coast Guard. Specifically, severance pay amounts that were withheld for tax purposes from veterans with combat-related injuries must be restored to veterans of the Coast Guard.

## **Actions Timeline**

- **May 24, 2023:** Sponsor introductory remarks on measure. (CR H2588)
- **May 8, 2023:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Coast Guard and Maritime Transportation.
- **May 5, 2023:** Introduced in House
- **May 5, 2023:** Referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure, and in addition to the Committee on Ways and Means, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
