Improving Outdoor Recreation Coordination Act

This bill directs the Department of the Interior to establish the Federal Interagency Council on Outdoor Recreation.

The council shall meet as frequently as appropriate for purposes of coordinating specified policies and activities, including

- recreation management policies across federal agencies;
- the response by federal land management agencies to public health or other emergencies that result in disruptions to, or closures of, federal recreational lands and waters;
- the adoption and expansion of emerging technologies on federal recreational lands and waters; and
- the dissemination to the public of recreation-related information in a manner that ensures that the information is easily accessible with modern communications devices.

Actions Timeline

- **Sep 19, 2023:** Subcommittee Hearings Held
- **Sep 18, 2023:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Federal Lands.
- **Jun 1, 2023:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Forestry.
- **May 5, 2023:** Introduced in House
- **May 5, 2023:** Referred to the Committee on Natural Resources, and in addition to the Committee on Agriculture, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
