Summary (as of May 9, 2023)

Travel for Care Act

This bill allows a tax exemption for employer-reimbursed travel expenses for abortion-related care. These are expenses incurred by an employee or employee family members for travel, including meals and lodging, to receive an abortion or follow-up care related to such abortion. The bill also allows a medical expense tax deduction for such abortion-related travel expenses.

Actions Timeline

- **Dec 17, 2024:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **May 12, 2023:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **May 9, 2023:** Introduced in House
- **May 9, 2023:** Sponsor introductory remarks on measure. (CR E407)
- **May 9, 2023:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committees on Education and the Workforce, and Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
