### Summary (as of Jan 12, 2023)

#### Protecting Homeowners from Disaster Act of 2023

This bill repeals the current limitation on tax deductions for personal casualty losses. Under current law, such losses are deductible in taxable years 2018-2025 only to the extent that they are attributable to a federally declared disaster.
