Summary (as of May 10, 2023)

Equitable Payments for Nursing Facilities Act of 2023

This bill allows the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services to adjust the federal per diem payment rate for Medicare skilled nursing facilities in Alaska or Hawaii to reflect the unique circumstances of such facilities.

Actions Timeline

- **Dec 17, 2024:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **May 12, 2023:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **May 10, 2023:** Introduced in House
- **May 10, 2023:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
