Sets forth the rule for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2811) to provide for a responsible increase to the debt ceiling, and for other purposes, and providing for consideration of the joint resolution (H.J. Res. 39) disapproving the rule submitted by the Department of Commerce relating to "Procedures Covering Suspension of Liquidation, Duties and Estimated Duties in Accord With Presidential Proclamation 10414".

Actions Timeline

- **Apr 26, 2023:** Introduced in House
- **Apr 26, 2023:** The House Committee on Rules reported an original measure, H. Rept. 118-43, by Mr. Cole.
- **Apr 26, 2023:** Resolution provides for two hours of general debate on H.R. 2811 and one hour of general debate on H.J. Res. 39. The previous question is considered as ordered with one motion to recommit allowed on each measure.
- **Apr 26, 2023:** Placed on the House Calendar, Calendar No. 14.
- **Apr 26, 2023:** Considered as privileged matter. (consideration: CR H1960-1977)
- **Apr 26, 2023:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with one hour of debate on H. Res. 327.
- **Apr 26, 2023:** POSTPONED PROCEEDINGS - At the conclusion of debate on H. Res. 327, the Chair put the question on ordering the previous question on the resolution, and by voice vote announced that the ayes had prevailed. Mr. McGovern demanded the yeas and nays and the Chair postponed further proceedings until a time to be announced.
- **Apr 26, 2023:** Considered as unfinished business. H. Res. 327 - "Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2811) to provide for a responsible increase to the debt ceiling, and for other purposes, and providing for consideration of the joint resolution (H.J.
