Summary (as of May 11, 2023)

Eliminate DEI in the Military Act

This bill prohibits the use of federal funds for diversity, equity, and inclusion activities (e.g., training) of the Armed Forces, national service academies, or the Department of Defense.

Actions Timeline

- **May 12, 2023:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Coast Guard and Maritime Transportation.
- **May 11, 2023:** Introduced in House
- **May 11, 2023:** Referred to the Committee on Armed Services, and in addition to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
