### Summary (as of May 16, 2023)

#### PI Post Acute Access Act

This bill allows for separate payment under Medicare to skilled nursing facilities for items and services that are needed to administer intravenous immune globin (IVIG) to patients with primary immune deficiency diseases (rare genetic disorders that impair the immune system and increase vulnerability for other infections).

## Actions Timeline

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- **Dec 17, 2024:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **May 19, 2023:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **May 16, 2023:** Introduced in House
- **May 16, 2023:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
