Facilitating Accountability In Reimbursements Act or the FAIR Act

This bill requires health care providers to use separate, unique health identifiers when submitting a claim to a health insurance issuer for services provided at an off-campus outpatient department.

Actions Timeline

- **Dec 17, 2024:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **May 19, 2023:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **May 17, 2023:** Introduced in House
- **May 17, 2023:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Ways and Means, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
