## Summary (as of May 25, 2023)

### National POW/MIA Memorial and Museum Act

This bill designates the memorial and museum that is being constructed on an approximately 26-acre area on the POW-MIA Memorial Parkway in Jacksonville, Florida, as the National POW/MIA Memorial and Museum.

The director of the memorial and museum shall submit a report to Congress that includes a budget for the memorial and museum.

## Actions Timeline

- **Jun 9, 2023:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Federal Lands.
- **May 25, 2023:** Introduced in House
- **May 25, 2023:** Referred to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs, and in addition to the Committee on Natural Resources, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
