Summary (as of May 25, 2023)

High School Sports Injury Reporting Act

This bill requires the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention to report to Congress about sports injury reporting requirements in high schools. The report must address topics including the availability of and tools used to collect data on sports injuries and recommend policies and other means of improving student athlete safety through sports injury reporting.

Actions Timeline

- **May 26, 2023:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **May 25, 2023:** Introduced in House
- **May 25, 2023:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Education and the Workforce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
