### **Pandemic is Over Act**

This bill terminates the COVID-19 public health emergency that was declared on January 31, 2020, on the date of the bill's enactment.

#### **Actions Timeline**

- Feb 1, 2023: Received in the Senate and Read twice and referred to the Committee on Health, Education, Labor, and Pensions.
- Jan 31, 2023: Rules Committee Resolution H. Res. 75 Reported to House. Rule provides for consideration of H.J. Res.
   7, H.R. 139, H.R. 382 and H.R. 497. All bills are considered under a closed rule with one hour of general debate and one motion to recommit.
- Jan 31, 2023: Considered under the provisions of rule H. Res. 75. (consideration: CR H531-539)
- Jan 31, 2023: Rule provides for consideration of H.J. Res. 7, H.R. 139, H.R. 382 and H.R. 497. All bills are considered under a closed rule with one hour of general debate and one motion to recommit.
- Jan 31, 2023: DEBATE The House proceeded with one hour of debate on H.R. 382.
- Jan 31, 2023: The previous question was ordered pursuant to the rule.
- Jan 31, 2023: Mr. Moskowitz moved to recommit to the Committee on Energy and Commerce. (text: CR H539)
- Jan 31, 2023: The previous question on the motion to recommit was ordered pursuant to clause 2(b) of rule XIX.
- Jan 31, 2023: POSTPONED PROCEEDINGS At the conclusion of debate on H.R. 382, the Chair put the question on the motion to recommit and by voice vote, announced that the noes had prevailed.
