USS Frank E. Evans Act

This bill requires the Department of Defense to authorize inclusion on the Vietnam Veterans Memorial Wall in the District of Columbia of the names of the 74 crew members of the USS *Frank E. Evans* killed on June 3, 1969.

Actions Timeline

- **Jun 9, 2023:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Federal Lands.
- **Jun 5, 2023:** Introduced in House
- **Jun 5, 2023:** Referred to the Committee on Armed Services, and in addition to the Committee on Natural Resources, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
