Rural Broadband Modernization Act

This bill reauthorizes through FY2028 and modifies a program that provides support for broadband access in rural areas. Among other modifications to the program, the bill establishes minimum upload and download capacities.

Actions Timeline

- **Jul 28, 2023:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Commodity Markets, Digital Assets, and Rural Development.
- **Jun 16, 2023:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Communications and Technology.
- **Jun 9, 2023:** Introduced in House
- **Jun 9, 2023:** Referred to the Committee on Agriculture, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
