### Summary (as of Jan 20, 2023)

#### Lead by Example Act of 2023

This bill provides that, beginning January 3, 2025, the only health care plan the federal government may make available to Members of Congress and congressional staff shall be health care provided through the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA).

By September 15, 2023, the VA and the Office of Personnel Management shall jointly submit to Congress a plan to carry out this bill, including recommendations for any necessary legislative actions.

## **Actions Timeline**

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- **Feb 8, 2023:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Jan 20, 2023:** Introduced in House
- **Jan 20, 2023:** Referred to the Committee on House Administration, and in addition to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
