Summary (as of Apr 17, 2024)

Flood Insurance Relief Act

This bill allows a new above-the-line tax deduction (used to determine adjusted gross income) for certain flood insurance premiums for taxpayers whose adjusted gross income does not exceed \$200,000 (\$400,000 for joint returns).
