Empowering Parents' Healthcare Choices Act of 2021

This bill provides a 60-day time frame within which parents with separate health insurance plans may choose which plan provides primary coverage for their newborn child. The bill limits the application of certain standard health insurance provisions that determine which plan becomes the primary coverage of a dependent child based on the order of the parents' birthdays.

Actions Timeline

- **Dec 17, 2024:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Jun 23, 2023:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Jun 16, 2023:** Introduced in House
- **Jun 16, 2023:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committees on Ways and Means, and Education and the Workforce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
