Summary (as of Jun 20, 2023)

Drain the Intelligence Community Swamp Act of 2023

This bill revokes the security clearances of 51 individuals who signed a statement titled *Public Statement on the Hunter Biden Emails* and dated October 19, 2020. It also (1) specifies that a security clearance may not be granted or renewed for any of them, and (2) requires the Departments of Defense and Justice to investigate these individuals.

Actions Timeline

- **Jun 12, 2024:** ASSUMING FIRST SPONSORSHIP - Mr. Biggs asked unanimous consent that he may hereafter be considered as the first sponsor of H.R. 4205, a bill originally introduced by Representative Santos, for the purpose of adding cosponsors and requesting reprintings pursuant to clause 7 of rule XII. Agreed to without objection.
- **Jun 20, 2023:** Introduced in House
- **Jun 20, 2023:** Referred to the Committee on Oversight and Accountability, and in addition to the Committees on the Judiciary, and Armed Services, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
