Summary (as of Jun 21, 2023)

Fund Our Border Not The IRS Act of 2023

This bill requires that unobligated amounts made available to the Internal Revenue Service under the Inflation Reduction Act of 2022 be transferred to pay expenses of Customs and Border Protection, for constructing and maintaining physical barriers along the southern U.S. border, and for other purposes relating to border security.

Actions Timeline

- **Jun 21, 2023:** Introduced in House
- **Jun 21, 2023:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committee on Homeland Security, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
- **Jun 21, 2023:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Border Security and Enforcement.
