Summary (as of Jun 21, 2023)

Child Tax Credit for Pregnant Moms Act of 2023

This bill allows a child tax credit for an unborn child who is born alive. It also allows the credit upon certification that a mother's pregnancy resulted in a miscarriage (the involuntary death of an unborn child who was carried in the womb for less than 20 weeks) or that the child was stillborn (the involuntary death of an unborn child who was carried in the womb for 20 weeks or more).

Actions Timeline

- **Jun 23, 2023:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Jun 21, 2023:** Introduced in House
- **Jun 21, 2023:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
