## **Thomas R. Carper Water Resources Development Act of 2024**

This bill authorizes, deauthorizes, and modifies various water resources feasibility studies and projects of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, such as studies or projects to

- make certain waterways more navigable,
- support water supply and storage projects,
- reduce flood and storm damage,
- restore aquatic ecosystems and conserve fish and wildlife,
- maintain ports and harbors,
- manage recreational sites and facilities,
- rehabilitate dams,
- construct water and wastewater infrastructure, and
- support other water resources infrastructure.
