### **Expanding Seniors' Access to PFAS Testing Act**

This bill provides for Medicare coverage of testing for perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) with no costsharing. (PFAS are man-made and may have adverse human health effects. A variety of products contain the compounds, such as nonstick cookware or weatherproof clothing.)

- Dec 17, 2024: Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- Jul 28, 2023: Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- Jul 26, 2023: Introduced in House
- Jul 26, 2023: Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Ways and Means, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
