Summary (as of Jul 28, 2023)

Fairness in Vineyard Data Act

This bill requires the National Agricultural Statistics Service (NASS) to conduct a survey, within one year of the bill's enactment, on grape production in each state and publish the data on the NASS website. In the following four years, NASS must make publicly available on the website data from the five states with the highest grape production in the preceding year.

Actions Timeline

- **Sep 19, 2023:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Conservation, Research, and Biotechnology.
- **Jul 28, 2023:** Introduced in House
- **Jul 28, 2023:** Referred to the House Committee on Agriculture.
