Summary (as of Jul 28, 2023)

Energy Accountability Act

This bill prohibits the Department of Energy (DOE) from making a loan guarantee under title XVII of the Energy Policy Act of 2005 for any entity that previously defaulted on an obligation under the title. Under that title, DOE must make loan guarantees for innovative energy technologies, such as technologies to reduce or sequester greenhouse gases.

## Actions Timeline

- **Aug 4, 2023:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Energy, Climate and Grid Security.
- **Jul 28, 2023:** Introduced in House
- **Jul 28, 2023:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Science, Space, and Technology, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
