Summary (as of Jan 25, 2023)

Ensure Vaccine Mandates Eliminate Non-Competes Act or the EVEN Act

This bill prohibits an employer from enforcing a noncompete agreement with an employee, or former employee, who has been fired for not receiving a COVID-19 vaccine.

The Federal Trade Commission and state attorneys general are authorized to enforce this bill.

Actions Timeline

- **Feb 3, 2023:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Jan 25, 2023:** Introduced in House
- **Jan 25, 2023:** Referred to the Committee on Education and the Workforce, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
