Freedom to Breathe Act

This bill prohibits the imposition of mask mandates on airplanes, public transit, or schools through December 31, 2024.

Actions Timeline

- **Sep 15, 2023:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Sep 11, 2023:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Aviation.
- **Sep 8, 2023:** Introduced in House
- **Sep 8, 2023:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committees on Transportation and Infrastructure, and Education and the Workforce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
