## **Taiwan Identification Terminology and Label Enhancement Act or the TITLE Act**

This bill requires all federal agencies to use the term *Taiwan* instead of *Chinese Taipei*.

The use of *Chinese Taipei* is allowed in (1) historical context to explain China's attempt to control Taiwan through persuasion and coercion, or (2) the formal title of a federal document. Agencies must update their websites to reflect this term no later than 14 days after enactment.
