Federal Information Resource to Strengthen Ties with State and Local Law Enforcement Act of 2023 or the FIRST State and Local Law Enforcement Act of 2023

This bill requires the Department of Homeland Security's Office for State and Local Law Enforcement to report annually on its activities.

Actions Timeline

- **Feb 8, 2023:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Counterterrorism, Law Enforcement, and Intelligence.
- **Jan 9, 2023:** Introduced in House
- **Jan 9, 2023:** Referred to the Committee on Homeland Security, and in addition to the Committee on the Judiciary, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
