- **Jul 12, 2023:** The House Committee on Rules reported an original measure, H. Rept. 118-141, by Mr. Cole.
- **Jul 12, 2023:** The resolution provides for consideration of H.R. 2670 under a structured rule with one hour of general debate. The resolution provides that the amendment in the nature of a substitute consisting of the text of Rules Committee Print 118-10, modified by the amendment printed in Part A of the Rules Committee report, shall be considered as adopted.
- **Jul 12, 2023:** Placed on the House Calendar, Calendar No. 28.
- **Jul 12, 2023:** Considered as privileged matter. (consideration: CR H3220-3229; text: CR H3220)
- **Jul 12, 2023:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with one hour of debate on H. Res. 582.
- **Jul 12, 2023:** POSTPONED PROCEEDINGS - At the conclusion of debate on H. Res. 582, the Chair put the question on ordering the previous question on the amendment and the resolution and by voice vote, announced the ayes had prevailed. Mr. McGovern demanded the yeas and nays and the Chair postponed further proceedings until a time to be announced.
- **Jul 12, 2023:** Considered as unfinished business. (consideration: CR H3229-3231)
- **Jul 12, 2023:** Passed/agreed to in House: On agreeing to the resolution, as amended Agreed to by recorded vote: 217 - 207 (Roll no. 294).
