Summary (as of Sep 29, 2023)

Medicare Advantage Consumer Protection and Transparency Act

This bill generally requires Medicare Advantage organizations to report additional information to the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services, including supplemental plan benefits, encounter data, and the number of coverage denials and prior authorization requests. Failure to comply with the bill's requirements may result in payment reductions.

Actions Timeline

- **Dec 17, 2024:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Oct 6, 2023:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Sep 29, 2023:** Introduced in House
- **Sep 29, 2023:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
