This resolution expresses support for Deep Vein Thrombosis and Pulmonary Embolism Awareness Month.

Deep vein thrombosis is a condition caused by a blood clot in the deep veins of the body; pulmonary embolisms (i.e., where a blood clot breaks off and lodges in the lung) are a potentially life-threatening complication of this condition.
