Iran-China Energy Sanctions Act of 2023

This bill requires the President to periodically determine whether any Chinese financial institution has engaged in the purchase of petroleum or petroleum products from Iran. U.S. financial institutions shall not open or maintain certain accounts with such Chinese financial institutions.

- **Apr 16, 2024:** Received in the Senate and Read twice and referred to the Committee on Banking, Housing, and Urban Affairs.
- **Apr 15, 2024:** Mr. McHenry moved to suspend the rules and pass the bill, as amended.
- **Apr 15, 2024:** Considered under suspension of the rules. (consideration: CR H2374-2376)
- **Apr 15, 2024:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with forty minutes of debate on H.R. 5923.
- **Apr 15, 2024:** At the conclusion of debate, the Yeas and Nays were demanded and ordered. Pursuant to the provisions of clause 8, rule XX, the Chair announced that further proceedings on the motion would be postponed.
