Summary (as of Oct 17, 2023)

Methane Emissions Reduction Act

This bill requires the Department of Energy to carry out a program to reduce methane emissions from flaring and venting natural gas during oil and natural gas production activities.

Actions Timeline

- Nov 3, 2023: Referred to the Subcommittee on Environment, Manufacturing, and Critical Materials.
- Oct 25, 2023: Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Science, Space, and Technology, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
- Oct 17, 2023: Introduced in House
