Summary (as of Oct 24, 2023)

Exchange Regulatory Improvement Act of 2023

This bill revises the definition of *facility* for purposes of regulation under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Specifically, the bill provides that a facility does not include any property, premises, or service that can legally be offered by a person or entity that is not required to be registered as an exchange.

Actions Timeline

- **Oct 25, 2023:** Referred to the House Committee on Financial Services.
- **Oct 24, 2023:** Introduced in House
