This resolution expresses the sense of the House of Representatives that (1) the United States should seek to prioritize the potential opportunities of technology and digital assets, and (2) Congress should enact a functional framework tailored to the specific risks of different digital asset-related activities.

Actions Timeline

- **Aug 21, 2023:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Commodity Markets, Digital Assets, and Rural Development.
- **Jul 21, 2023:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Innovation, Data, and Commerce.
- **Jul 20, 2023:** Introduced in House
- **Jul 20, 2023:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committees on Financial Services, and Agriculture, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
