Summary (as of Oct 26, 2023)

Commission To Study the Potential Creation of a National Museum of American LGBTQI+ History and Culture Act

This bill establishes the Commission to Study the Potential Creation of a National Museum of American LGBTQI+ History and Culture.

The commission must submit reports that address

- the feasibility of establishing and maintaining such a museum,
- the availability and cost of collections to be acquired and housed in the museum,
- the impact of the museum on existing American LGBTQI+ history-related museums,
- development of criteria for evaluating possible locations for the museum, and
- the feasibility of the museum becoming part of the Smithsonian Institution.

The commission must develop a fundraising plan that will address the support of the museum through contributions from the public. No federal funds may be obligated to carry out this bill.

Actions Timeline

- **Oct 26, 2023:** Introduced in House
- **Oct 26, 2023:** Referred to the Committee on Natural Resources, and in addition to the Committees on House Administration, and the Budget, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
