Summary (as of Dec 19, 2023)

Department of Homeland Security Policy Issuance Review Act

This bill requires the Management Directorate of the Department of Homeland Security to periodically review policy issuance documents (such as department-level directives and instructions, but excluding certain documents such as those published in the Federal Register). The bill also requires the directorate to brief Congress on various aspects of this review process within 180 days of enactment and annually thereafter.

- **Dec 19, 2024:** Placed on Senate Legislative Calendar under General Orders. Calendar No. 753.

- **Sep 24, 2024:** Received in the Senate and Read twice and referred to the Committee on Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs.

- **Sep 23, 2024:** Considered under suspension of the rules. (consideration: CR H5591-5592)
