Student Loan Relief for Medicare and Social Security Recipients Act of 2023

This bill requires the Department of Education to forgive the outstanding balance of principal, interest, and fees due on eligible federal student loans for borrowers who are recipients of Medicare or Social Security Disability Insurance.

Actions Timeline

- **Dec 8, 2023:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Dec 7, 2023:** Introduced in House
- **Dec 7, 2023:** Referred to the Committee on Education and the Workforce, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
