Hydrogen for Ports Act

This bill supports infrastructure for hydrogen-derived fuels, including ammonia, at ports and in the shipping industry. Specifically, the Department of Energy must establish a program for infrastructure that supports the use of such fuels at ports and in the shipping industry. States, local governments, tribal governments, certain private entities, and other eligible entities may apply for grants.

Actions Timeline

- **Jan 2, 2024:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Coast Guard and Maritime Transportation.
- **Dec 22, 2023:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Environment, Manufacturing, and Critical Materials.
- **Dec 19, 2023:** Introduced in House
- **Dec 19, 2023:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
