Every Kid Outdoors Reauthorization Act

This bill revises and permanently reauthorizes the Every Kid Outdoors Program, which provides passes for free access to federal lands and waters to certain students and accompanying individuals.

Actions Timeline

- **Aug 29, 2024:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Forestry.
- **Jan 19, 2024:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Water Resources and Environment.
- **Jan 9, 2024:** Introduced in House
- **Jan 9, 2024:** Referred to the Committee on Natural Resources, and in addition to the Committees on Agriculture, and Transportation and Infrastructure, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
