Actions Timeline

- **Sep 26, 2023:** Introduced in House
- **Sep 26, 2023:** The House Committee on Rules reported an original measure, H. Rept. 118-216, by Mr. Roy.
- **Sep 26, 2023:** The resolution provides for consideration of H.R. 4365, H.R. 4367, H.R. 4368, and H.R. 4665, under a structured rule for each bill. The resolution provides for one hour of general debate for each bill and one motion to recommit.
- **Sep 26, 2023:** Placed on the House Calendar, Calendar No. 38.
- **Sep 26, 2023:** By direction of the Committee on Rules, Mr. Roy called up H. Res. 723 and asked for its immediate consideration.
- **Sep 26, 2023:** POINT OF ORDER - Mr. McGovern raised a point of order against the provisions of H. Res. 723 on the grounds that the resolution violates section 426(a) of the Congressional Budget Act of 1974. The Chair announced that the disposition of the point of order would be resolved by the question of consideration of H. Res. 723. The House proceeded with 20 minutes of debate on the point of order at the end of which the Chair will put the question on consideration as the statutory means of disposing of the point of order.
- **Sep 26, 2023:** Mr. Roy moved on consideration of the resolution.
- **Sep 26, 2023:** On consideration of the resolution Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 209 - 198 (Roll no. 404).
- **Sep 26, 2023:** Considered as privileged matter. (consideration: CR H4480-4495)
- **Sep 26, 2023:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with one hour of debate on H. Res. 723.
- **Sep 26, 2023:** On ordering the previous question Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 215 - 209 (Roll no. 405).
- **Sep 26, 2023:** Passed/agreed to in House: On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by recorded vote: 216 - 212 (Roll no. 406). (text: CR H4480-4481)
- **Sep 26, 2023:** On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by recorded vote: 216 - 212 (Roll no. 406). (text: CR H4480-4481)
