Actions Timeline

- **Sep 29, 2023:** Introduced in House
- **Sep 29, 2023:** The House Committee on Rules reported an original measure, H. Rept. 118-230, by Mr. Reschenthaler.
- **Sep 29, 2023:** Rule provides for consideration of H.R. 5525 with 1 hour of general debate. Motion to recommit allowed. Bill is closed to amendments.
- **Sep 29, 2023:** Placed on the House Calendar, Calendar No. 40.
- **Sep 29, 2023:** Considered as privileged matter. (consideration: CR H4861-4869)
- **Sep 29, 2023:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with one hour of debate on H. Res. 741.
- **Sep 29, 2023:** On ordering the previous question Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 217 - 207 (Roll no. 508).
- **Sep 29, 2023:** POSTPONED PROCEEDINGS - At the conclusion of debate on H. Res. 741, the Chair put the question on agreeing to the resolution and by voice vote announced that the ayes had prevailed. Mr. McGovern demanded a recorded vote and the Chair postponed further proceedings until a time to be announced.
- **Sep 29, 2023:** UNFINISHED BUSINESS - The Chair announced the unfinished business was the question on agreeing to H. Res. 741. (consideration: CR H4869)
- **Sep 29, 2023:** Passed/agreed to in House: On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by recorded vote: 218 - 210 (Roll no. 509). (text: CR H4861)
