The resolution also expresses support for increased education in schools to better reflect the sacrifice of veterans of the Vietnam war and the lack of support they received in the United States. Additionally, the resolution expresses regret for the mistreatment of veterans and their families during and after the Vietnam war and urges the President to formally acknowledge the widespread mistreatment of such veterans.
