Summary (as of Feb 6, 2023)

Investing in Safer Traffic Stops Act of 2023

This bill directs the Department of Justice to establish a grant program for state, local, or tribal government entities to ensure that the enforcement of traffic violations is carried out by a civilian or traffic monitoring technology instead of a law enforcement officer.

Actions Timeline

- **Feb 7, 2023:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Highways and Transit.
- **Feb 6, 2023:** Introduced in House
- **Feb 6, 2023:** Referred to the Committee on the Judiciary, and in addition to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
