This resolution expresses strong support for democracy in Pakistan, including free and fair elections. It calls on the President to work with Pakistan to uphold democracy, human rights, and the rule of law. The resolution also urges Pakistan to uphold democratic institutions and human rights.

Actions Timeline

- **Jun 25, 2024:** Mr. McCormick moved to suspend the rules and agree to the resolution, as amended.
