Summary (as of Dec 12, 2023)

This resolution sets forth the rule for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1147) to amend the Richard B. Russell National School Lunch Act to allow schools that participate in the school lunch program under such act to serve whole milk.

It further provides for consideration of the bill (H.R. 357) to require the head of an agency to issue and sign any rule issued by that agency.

- **Dec 11, 2023:** The resolution provides for consideration of H.R. 1147 under a structured rule with one hour of general debate and H.R. 357 under a closed rule with one hour of general debate. The resolution provides for a motion to recommit on both measures. It also provides that on any legislative day of the second session of the 118th Congress before January 9, 2024, the Speaker may dispense with organizational and legislative business and that the Journal of the proceedings of the previous day shall be considered as approved if applicable.
- **Dec 11, 2023:** Placed on the House Calendar, Calendar No. 53.
