### Summary (as of Apr 9, 2025)

#### Supporting American Allies Act

This bill exempts articles imported into the United States from Israel or Ukraine from additional tariffs imposed by an April 2, 2025, [executive order](#).

On April 2, 2025, President Donald J. Trump signed an executive order imposing an additional 10% tariff on most imports to the United States and additional country-specific tariffs on 57 trading partners (including a 17% tariff on Israel).

Therefore, this executive order imposes an additional 10% tariff on imports from Ukraine and an additional 17% tariff on imports from Israel. This bill exempts articles from Israel or Ukraine from these additional tariffs.
