Flatside Wilderness Additions Act

This bill adds specified lands to the Flatside Wilderness in the Ouachita National Forest in Arkansas. The bill also redesignates the wilderness as the Flatside-Bethune Wilderness.

Actions Timeline

- **May 14, 2025:** Received in the Senate and Read twice and referred to the Committee on Agriculture, Nutrition, and Forestry.
- **May 13, 2025:** Mr. Westerman moved to suspend the rules and pass the bill.
- **May 13, 2025:** Considered under suspension of the rules. (consideration: CR H1966-1969)
- **May 13, 2025:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with forty minutes of debate on H.R. 1612.
- **May 13, 2025:** Passed/agreed to in House: On motion to suspend the rules and pass the bill Agreed to by voice vote. (text: CR H1967)
